

Venice High School Student Parking Policy

Parking your personal vehicle on campus is a privilege. Please carefully read the policy below and indicate your agreement by checking the box when you request your account.

- Your parking permit cannot be transferred. You cannot trade, loan, share, sell, or give it to others. You cannot use your permit on more than one vehicle.
- Your permit must always be correctly displayed on your driver's side lower windshield.
- You must park in your designated area (General, Pool, VPAC)
- You may **not** go to the parking lot or to your vehicle during the day. No exceptions!
- ➤ If you leave campus in your vehicle during school hours without an early dismissal/clinic pass or proper permission, you may lose your parking permit with no refund or receive a referral.
- Any behavior resulting in out-of-school suspension, or a second chance agreement may result in the loss of your parking permit with no refund.
- ➢ If you have 8 or more unexcused absences, 60 or more unexcused absent periods, or 8 or more 1st period tardies in a semester, you may lose your permit.
- ➤ If you have **OJT and you have 60 or more unexcused absence periods**, you may be given a full day schedule on campus.
- ➤ The maximum speed limit on VHS campus is **5 mph**. **Students parking in the Pool and General lot will enter by the pool/building 30 gates.** Careless driving on campus may result a discipline referral and loss of your parking permit with no refund. (Sarasota School Board Policy 5.36 and Discipline Matrix 300.37)
- According to School Board Policy 5.31, student vehicles parked on campus are subject to search, upon reasonable suspicion, for prohibited items or illegal substances. As the owner of the parking permit, you will be held responsible for any prohibited items in the vehicle. Failure to submit to a search may result in loss of parking privileges without a refund.
- Any changes to your vehicle information must be updated on VHSparking.com. Failure to update your information may result in the loss of your permit without a refund.
- > Vehicles found in violation of any parking policy will be issued a citation and may be assigned the following consequences:
 - Student not parked in their designated area/spot \$10.
 - Parking without a permit in your window \$10
- > Failure to pay fines within 10 days may result in loss of parking permit with no refund.
- A replacement parking permit can be purchased for \$25 in the 3rd floor admin. Suite.
